


Subject	2nd Half Term
English 	In English we are learning - <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ To write poems, explanations and diary entries ➤ To write letters, instructions and scenes for a film linking to our History topic Mary Seacole <p>During our Read Write Inc lessons we will be learning different sounds to help us develop our reading and writing.</p>
Mathematics 	In Mathematics we are learning to- <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Practise our 2,5 and 10 times tables ➤ Double and halve numbers to 20 and beyond ➤ To interpret the data contained in a grid ➤ Read, write and order numbers correctly to 1000s <p>Additionally there will be a maths challenges which will consist of maths games and word problems.</p>
Science / Grow It / Cook It 	Plants <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Observe and describe how seeds and blubs grow into mature plants ➤ Find out and describe how plants need water, light and suitable temperature to grow and stay healthy <p><i>Cook It / Grow It - Use a juice squeezer and create a Caribbean Fruit Salad</i></p>
Computing / Film It 	<p>We will be learning how to use computer programs safely.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ What it is and how to use an email address ➤ Use recording cameras to record and the Movie Maker to edit a film
History / Geography 	Mary Seacole <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Learn about why Mary Seacole is famous ➤ Make comparisons in hospitals now and then ➤ Learn about the Crimean War
Art / Design Technology 	Textiles <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Telling the story of Mary Seacole through patchwork sewing ➤ Choose an important part of Mary Seacole's life and design a patch piece in using ➤ Using sewing techniques
Music 	Exploring Pitch <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Use voices to make long and short sounds ➤ Use percussion instruments to make sounds of differing duration
Religious Education 	How do we know that Easter is coming and what special story is told at Easter? <p>The children will be learning about creation stories and how they know Easter is coming.</p>
Physical Education 	Outdoor P.E <p>Team games through playing Rounder's</p> Indoor P.E <p>Exploring movement through dance</p>
