


Subject	2 nd Half Term
English 	In English we will be learning, <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Writing in narrative verse ➤ Non-fiction - explanation text ➤ Using synonyms and adverbials
Mathematics 	In Mathematics we will be learning, <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Calculate percentages of amounts ➤ Use a pair of compasses to draw 2d shapes ➤ Calculate terms in equations ➤ Rounding decimal numbers ➤ Solving word problems
Religious Education 	Reflecting on, 'What makes me the person I am?' <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Reflect on different aspects of their identity, on ideas about what is distinctive about them and what they share with others and the world around them ➤ Discuss who or what influences their lives? ➤ Reflect on things they are about in the world and objects that remind them of the special times in their lives
Music 	Singing <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Sing expressively with awareness and control of the expressive elements ➤ Recognise simple structures
Computing 	Film Making <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Create a short film/animation to convey a message of choice
Modern Foreign Languages – Spanish 	In Spanish we will be learning the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Describing people, places, things and actions orally and in writing. ➤ Key phrases ➤ Present continuous
Physical Education 	Outdoor P.E - Athletics (Field/Track) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Develop strength and stamina in running and throwing ➤ Run distances over hurdles ➤ Perform baton changeover from standing Indoor P.E- Carnival Dance <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Perform dances using simple movement patterns ➤ Repeat individual moves and link a series of at least four moves

The aim of World of work and Enterprise: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ To develop children's awareness of the world of work and work related concepts and vocabulary ➤ To increase understanding of a variety of occupations and roles, and help prevent stereotypes around gender and cultural suitability for particular jobs ➤ To demonstrate the links between learning in school and success in adult life ➤ To develop children's financial capability from a young age and increase understanding of why people earn and save money ➤ To develop children's sense of responsibility and their skills for co-operation, enterprise and problem solving
