












Subject	2nd Half Term

What are the consequences of being unsafe online? How do we stay safe online? Who should we talk to online? What should we look out for online? How should we behave online?
History / Geography 	Fair-Trade <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Learn about Fair-trade products ➤ Create multi-sensory maps ➤ Develop deep ideas about fairness
Art / Design Technology 	Designing badges to support Fairtrade <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Investigate meanings of logos ➤ Develop ideas about suitability of materials ➤ Evaluating products
Music 	Exploring Sound Colours <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Listening to music that describes an event, scene, person or an animal ➤ Choose a picture that allows scope for aural interpretation ➤ Painting pictures in sound
Religious Education 	Hindu worship <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Explore ways in which Hindus understand God ➤ Think about the importance of worship at home and in a religious building
