











Subject	2 nd Half Term

History / Geography 	The United Kingdom <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Learn all about the United Kingdom ➤ Names of the countries and some key cities ➤ Recognise it in a map and which continent it belongs to ➤ Learn about London and some of the changes that have happened and visit an historic location in London
Art / Design Technology 	Create a United Colours of Britain Collage <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Develop our sketching skills by observing and drawing natural objects ➤ Make a collage which reflects our knowledge of the United Kingdom
Music 	Singing- Recognise phrase lengths and know when to breathe <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Learn traditional songs about plants, flowers and growing. ➤ Recognise phrase lengths and know when to breathe when singing ➤ Explore how we can use instruments to make music which gives a message or tells a story.
Religious Education 	How do Christians celebrate Christmas? <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ We will be learning about how Christians celebrate Christmas and the stories and beliefs behind some of the customs
Physical Education 	Outdoor PE Developing ball control further through various throwing and kicking activities and games. Indoor PE Developing our recent work on balance into developing the children's ability to perform key rolling techniques.
