











Subject	1st Half Term
English 	In English we are learning - <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ To read play scripts with an emphasis on exploring characters' thoughts and feelings and the impact of sound effects. ➤ To write a play script ➤ About persuasive writing style <p>During our Read Write Inc lessons, we will be learning different sounds to help us develop our reading and writing.</p>
Mathematics 	In Mathematics we are learning - <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Arithmetic - Number puzzles; Number sequences; Maths stories ➤ Geometry - Symmetry; Right angles ➤ Data and measure - Money problems <p>Additionally there will be a maths challenges which will consist of maths games and word problems.</p>
Science / Grow It / Cook It 	Living things and their habitats (food chains) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Find out that suitable food sources are one of the main criteria for animals to survive in a particular habitat. ➤ Describe how animals obtain their food from plants and other animals, using the idea of a simple food chain, and identify and name different sources of food
Computing / Film It 	Capturing Skills <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Explore using different camera shots of the local area ➤ Learn how to download and print images
History / Geography 	Compare England with Africa <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Choose an African country they wish to study, use maps, atlases, globes and digital/computer mapping to locate continents ➤ Compare Africa with England. How are they the same or different? What facilities might a town or a village need?
Art / Design Technology 	African Art <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Look the work of African artists ➤ Reproduce African art/ patterns through sketching and painting ➤ Choose and create a colour palette to reflect Africa
Music 	Exploring Timbre, Tempo & Dynamics <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Comparing music from Africa and the UK ➤ Talk about the different kinds of weather that make a sound ➤ Experiment with different beaters, with dynamics, tempos and duration. ➤ Encourage the children to try putting sounds together using words/voices and instruments
Religious Education 	Why do some people eat special foods? <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Explore the practice of eating special foods in Islam and Sikhism ➤ Understand the symbolism of the foods and why they are important to believers ➤ Explore foods in the local area e.g. Green Street ➤ Learn about special foods that are eaten at a religious festival
Physical Education 	Outdoor P.E. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Athletics - Challenge self and others in jumping and throwing Indoor P.E. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Gymnastics- move like an animal.
Philosophy for Children (P4C / Ask It) 	Through the subject of Philosophy For Children (P4C) we will be developing - <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Debating skills ➤ Questioning skills Big Question- Do we find similarities and differences?
