












Subject	2 nd Half Term
English 	In English we will be learning about - <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Fiction and Non-fiction text ➤ Playscripts and instruction texts ➤ Science fiction/ Fantasy and Discussion texts ➤ Poetic language and Mystery
Mathematics 	In Mathematics we will be learning about- <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Arithmetic - Write Maths stories on vertical additions and subtraction ➤ Geometry - Recognise parallel and not parallel lines ➤ Data and measure - Decide which units to use when measuring length ➤ Reasoning - Write ratios using fractions
Science /Grow It/ Cook It 	Animals and Humans <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Food groups and balanced diets ➤ The main function of skeletons: support function and movement ➤ Muscles and joints and effects of exercise <i>Cook It / Grow It - Use whisking skills to make bread and butter pudding</i>
Computing / Film It 	Presentations <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Create a presentation, which moves from slide to slide and is aimed at a specific audience ➤ Know how to manipulate text ➤ Record a narration for digital image
History /Geography 	Battle of Britain <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Learn about World War II how it started and why. ➤ Explore what happened during the Blitz and the need for evacuation ➤ Understand the effect of war on everyday life
Art / Design Technology 	Drawing <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Sketch and add detail using postcards from World War II ➤ Discuss the composition- the people and how they are related? ➤ Trace images onto paper and colour in blocks like a cartoon
Music 	Descriptive Sounds <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Listen to pieces of music and examine how rhythm and melody are used to describe an animal ➤ Compose our own music using instruments to describe two animals
Religious Education 	Religious Symbols <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Learn about ways in which art, signs and symbols are used in religion to express faith ➤ Reflect on important signs and symbols in our own lives and relate to religious symbols
Physical Education 	Outdoor P.E Developing technique and control through Tennis Indoor P.E Develop our dance skills and perform a Battle of Britain dance
Philosophy for Children (P4C /Ask It) 	Through the subject of Philosophy For Children (P4C) we will be developing <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Debating skills ➤ Questioning skills Big Question - Do we identify changes in thinking?
Modern Foreign Languages – Spanish 	We will be building on our Spanish from last term and learning, <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Animals- <i>horse, spider, tiger, crocodile, swan, dove</i> ➤ Classroom phrases- <i>what's missing? I would like...</i> ➤ Verbs such as <i>to fly, to run, to swim, to trot</i> ➤ Numbers <i>10-20</i>
