











Subject	2 nd Half Term

History / Geography 	Exploration - Neil Armstrong <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ His life and achievements ➤ Visiting the moon
Art / Design Technology 	Painting- Art space <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Observe and discuss paintings by different artists such as Peter Thorpe ➤ Use different brushstrokes and colours to create effect
Music 	Exploring Sounds <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Use voices to make long and short sounds. ➤ Use percussion instruments to make sounds of differing duration and learn a song about animals
